Ahead of returning to school in September, we celebrated our 2022 – 2023 Year Eleven cohort's fabulous results. We were so happy to see every year eleven collect their results in August, so that we could congratulate them on their well-deserved outcomes. We will continue to be in contact with parents/carers about the different speakers, visits and opportunities that will be on offer between now and June 2024 for our pupils to access, including further events for families to come together and explore what options Derby, and beyond, has to offer. Thank you to parents/carers that have been in to speak with us already, meet with P16 providers and to support their children when needed, to fulfil their potentials fully.

It has also been fabulous to welcome our largest year seven cohort (ever) into our school community. They look wonderful in their new uniform and the staff team have been very impressed with how well they have transitioned into school – it has been good getting to know and meet some of their parents and carers – we recognise and value the difference it makes



when we are all working together to support our pupils through this transition into school, and beyond.

This past half-term we have seen our different school clubs begin again (Football, Basketball, Science, Baking and more) and will look to grow the offer over the coming months. Please encourage your child to speak to their key workers about what clubs they may wish to try and also to let us know what club they might want us to offer – we are always keen to try new things!

In September we ran two successful charity events – well supported by pupils, parents/carers and staff. On 18th September we held our first charity event of the year, in support of 'Jeans for Genes'. Pupils and staff dressed up to support this worthwhile cause and raised a fabulous £215. Well done to Nigel our Site Manager and Tracey, one of our school's administration assistants for winning the 'Best Dressed Staff' competition.

On the 29th September we held a 'Macmillan Coffee Morning' which was for some year seven parents/carers, a great opportunity to come and see their children at their secondary school for the first time. Thank you and well done to pupils and staff who worked together across the key stages to raise £150!

We are now taking collections for our 'Christmas Shoe Box' appeal. All of our fundraising is part of our curriculum work developing pupils' social emotional skills; putting others first; showing empathy towards others and exercising responsibility to organise and help worthwhile causes.

Returning to school in September we were thrilled to see the majority of our pupils arrive in uniform or in line with our uniform expectations wearing black. Parent and carer support around this expectation is of course well received. If your child is still not wearing black, please can you support them and let us know if you need any support.
